Our garage is full of toys for the special Christmas sacks that we will be giving out to the poor children in just a few days. I personally went to the capital this year and did most of the buying. I had plenty of people that I could have sent but this was one thing I wanted to do and it was a blessing. Thank you for bringing joy to thousands of little children this year. We plan to go out into the country side and give out many of these sacks. We will also be going into the hospitals and for the first time we will be giving sacks to children of the men and women in the jails...always making sure that everyone knows that Jesus was our very special gift who in turn has given us eternal life by dying for us on the cross.

Since our last newsletter, we have had two very special conferences on the home and marriage. Our dear friends, Tommy and Mary Lynn Crider, were here for their Annual Heart and Home conference, bringing several of their people. Jane Keel was back again and she is a blessing to everyone with her singing. The River of Life Baptist Church in Papalon, Honduras, constructed by funds they raised in their conferences in the states, was dedicated while they were here, and since their return to the U.S., they have raised funds to build a children's kitchen and S.S. rooms...







Olen and Betty Wallace, from Powder Springs, Georgia, whom we have known for many years, were burdened to build a pastorium for a pastor and we recommended the pastor at Papalon. This young preacher, who is one of our Bible Institute graduates, and his family were living in one room in the old school house in Papalon in conditions not fit for animals but you would have never known it by his joy and enthusiasm over what God is doing in Papalon. Olen and Betty provided the money for us to build a beautiful pastorium and they came for the dedication. I have never seen so many children in one church in all my life....He averages over 150 children every Sunday. Can you imagine what the village of Papalon will be like in the future should the Lord not return soon...We thank the Lord for Brother Tommy, Mary Lynn and all the Heart and Home people and we thank Brother Olen and Sister Betty for hearts of compassion.

Our second conference was held by Brother Billy Wood and Bruce Snead from the Grace Baptist Church in Powder Springs, Georgia. Over 150 pastors and their wives were present for this conference and what a time we had...The conference started with a banquet on Wednesday night and ended on Friday afternoon with all these pastors and their wives in the altar rededicating their lives and homes. It was a precious sight. We filled all three motels in town plus our Bible Institute, dorms, visitors quarters, and every other place we could find. We thank the Lord for all the mission cooks who provided delicious meals. We especially thank the Beams Ministry for three thousand Bibles that were donated to the Good Samaritan Baptist Missions and given out to these pastors to take back to their villages.

Another special occasion was the ordination of 11 pastors in Nicaragua. Many churches were represented for this special occasion and a baptism followed with 23 following the Lord in believers baptism. Pastor Robbie Robinson from Wrenn Memorial Baptist Church in Greenville, South Carolina was with us and participated in the ordination and baptism.

The last week of November is normally one of our happiest times of the year as the whole week is filled with graduations from our high school, grammar school and our Bible School here in San Marcos, plus two grammar schools and one high school in Nicaragua. This year, during the week of graduations, the Lord called home one of our national pastors who was our high school Bible teacher. Brother Carlos Salgado, who had been with us for over 20 years, was riding his motorcycle with his 12 year old son when a drunk driver came out of a side street and hit him at a high rate of speed. Carlos never regained consciousness and died November 22, the day of our high school graduation. His son has just recently been released from the hospital with a broken leg, broken arm and several other injuries. Please pray for this family. Carlos'wife, Ena, is a counselor at our girls'dorm. This is the first time in the history of our mission that we have lost a pastor but we know that "our loss is heaven's gain".

From the Tyson family and all the family of the Good Samaritan Baptist Missions, our desire for all of you is a very, very MERRY CHRIST-MAS and a happy and healthy New Year. Thank you for helping to make 2005 a fruitful year for the Lord here on the mission fields of Honduras, Nicaragua, Costa Rica, Mexico and Puerto Rico. May God so richly bless you.
